- The scheme focussed on brand owners having CE Certificates
- The issue now is clearly non-compliant/non-performing products

Recent Product Issues

- Non-Compliant/Non-Performing Footwear
- Non-Compliant Safety Helmets
- Non-Compliant Gloves
- Non-Compliant Hi Vis Clothing
- HSE/HSL published RR 1087
 - 2 out of 10 Filtering Face Masks (Cat III) failed
 - Findings passed through BEIS to Trading Standards

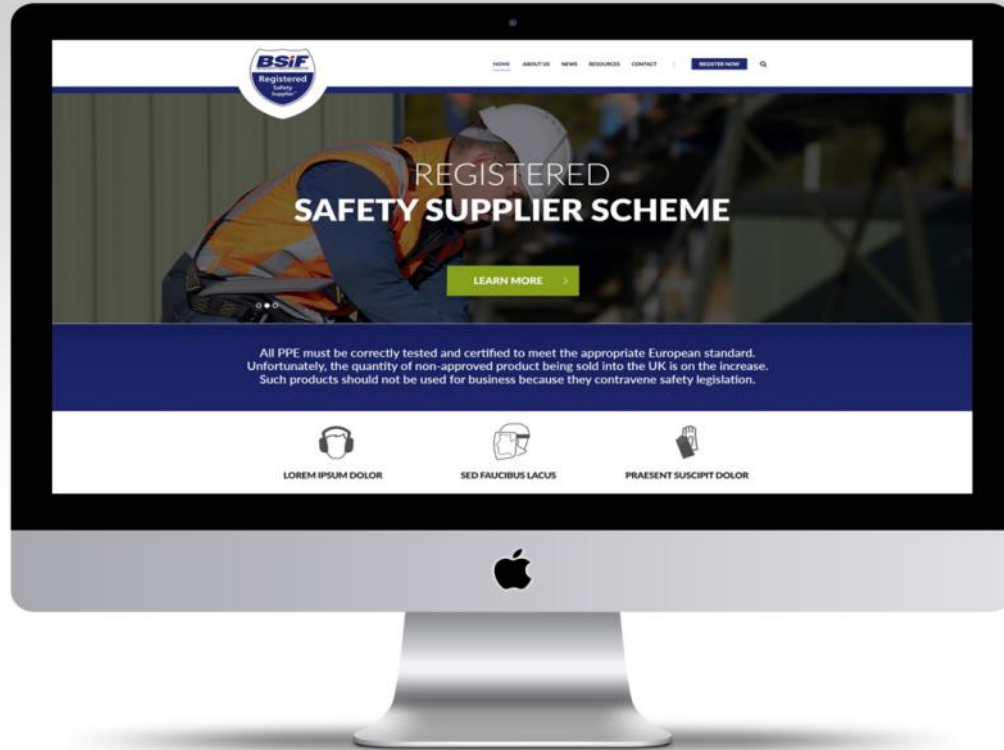
